#### Dear Families.

We are really pleased to have had such a positive start to the school year. It is amazing how quickly the last month has flown by and how brilliantly the children have settled back in to school and coped with the new routines. We hope that families have found the revised procedures introduced over the past few weeks for pick-ups and drop offs beneficial. Thank you for working with us on this to support with keeping everyone safe on the school sites.

#### Please do remember:

- Only to arrive during your designated time slots (or those of siblings if you have a child in a different year group in the same school);
- We encourage parents to wear a face mask during pick-up and drop offs our thanks to many of you who are now wearing them during these times;
- Parents should not congregate outside the gates either before / after dropping off or picking up children from school.

As the weather has turned a little colder, and wetter this week, we do ask that children come to school with a coat every day. A reminder too that children are to arrive in PE kit on their PE days and are advised to also bring a change of clothes with them (just in case they get wet or muddy). Children may also like to wear jogging bottoms rather than shorts as it is a little cold during outside PE.

#### School Lunches

We have been working closely with the kitchen staff and are delighted that we have now been able to introduce more hot meal options for children. Children continue to eat their lunches in classrooms at present, however we have been able to facilitate a 'take-away' style lunch time service. These are proving really popular, so do take a look if you have not done so already.

We appreciate this makes applying difficult and want to support parents by providing as much information as we can in different ways. #### Parking/Car Park

Families should ensure they use the pathways and not walk across the car park as a small number of authorised vehicles do require access during this time.

We also ask that parents parking outside the school, do so with consideration to our neighbours. We have been notified that some parents are continuing to park on dropped curbs, over people's driveways or use their driveways to turn around in.


