PSHE

Learning to care for our environment.
How sleep and eating a balanced diet is important to keep us healthy and how to use basic hygiene to help our bodies.

Maths

Addition and Subtraction and fact families –Use and learn number bonds within 10 Read, write and interpret +, -, = correctly in different number sentences. Add and subtract 1 digit numbers within 10. Children to use number lines and practice using mental strategies. Solve simple addition and subtraction word problems using objects and pictures.

Shape- Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes

Place value- Count to 20 forwards and backwards from any given number. Identify 1 more and 1 less at speed of numbers to 20. Identify and compare numbers using objects, pictures and number lines. Use mathematical language to compare amounts.

Practise at home counting forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s, and 10s, Finding 1 more or 1 less than a given number to 20 Using correct number orientation. Please continue to practice writing numerals 0-10 correctly.

Computing

Learning to programme and direct Beebot robots around maps and obstacles.

Art & Design

Bonfire night painting and night time pictures using silhouettes.
Drawing and creating Remembrance poppies.
