Number and Place Value. (Weeks 1-5) Count to 10, identify one more and one less; identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least; read and write numbers from 1 to 10 in numerals and words. Count backwards from 10 from any number e.g. 7, 6, 5

Addition and Subtraction (Weeks 6-7) Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition +, subtraction - and equals signs =; represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10; add and subtract one-digit numbers to 10, including zero; solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction,

Please help at home by practising writing the numerals 0-10 neatly and correctly with your child and counting backwards from 10. Count different objects at home and record the amount you count. If your child is confident, try numerals to 20.
