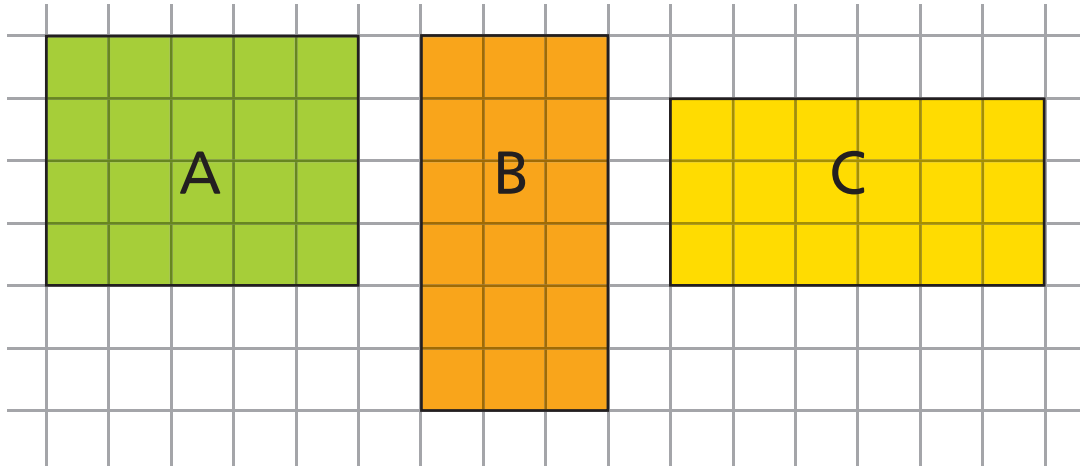


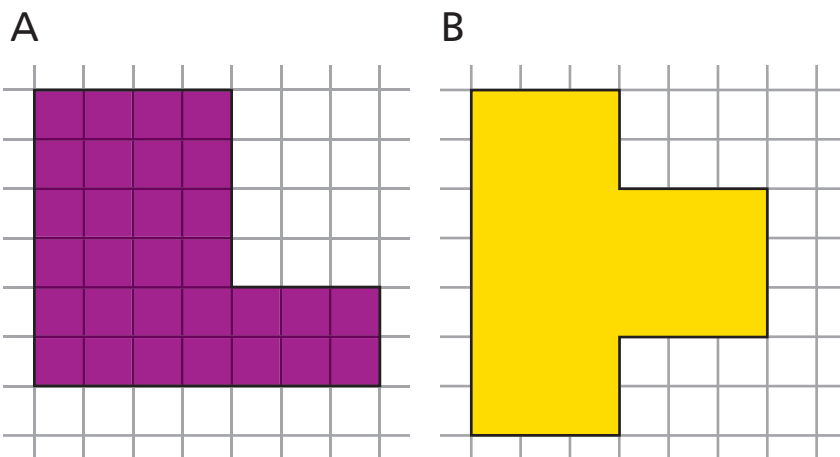
Think together

- 2 Work out the areas of these two rectilinear shapes.



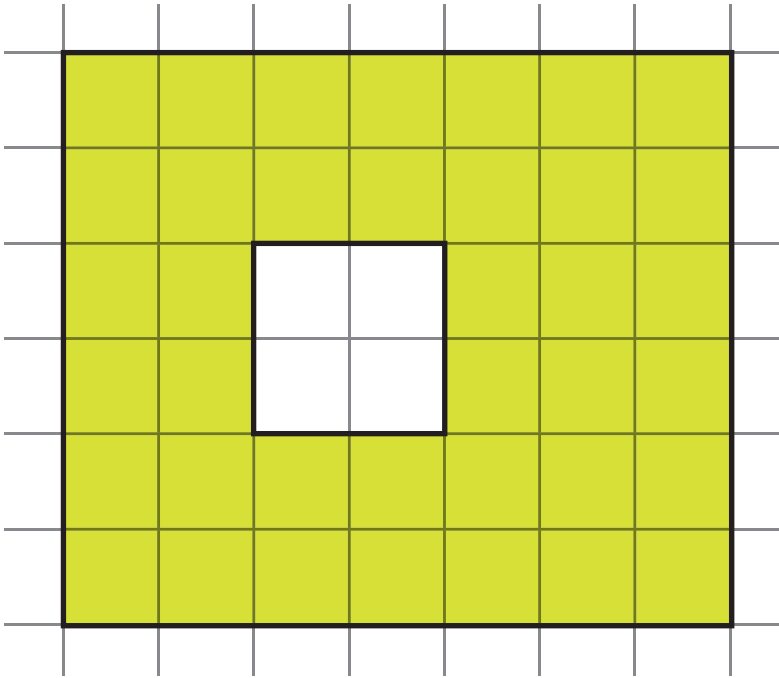
A = squares B = squares

A rectilinear shape is a shape with straight sides that always meet at right angles. Squares and rectangles are rectilinear shapes.
