Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, we would like to thank you all for your continued support and commitment to the Breakfast and After School Club (Kites). This provision continues to go from strength to strength and it is clear how much the children enjoy their time in these clubs.

Both these clubs are self-financing and are run as a “not for profit” venture. Fees are used to employ the Club staff – salaries are not funded by the school - and to pay for food, running costs and activity resources. We have seen these costs increasing as the clubs have become more popular and have not increased our costs since 2017. It has also become apparent that since we have returned in September there are also a number of additional costs that both clubs are incurring in order to comply with the protective measures for holiday and after-school clubs, and other out-of-school settings during the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak.

We have completed a comprehensive review of all costs and in light of this we are writing to you to let you know that we will be implementing the following price rises for all bookings made after Monday 7th December 2020.

The Breakfast Club will increase from £4.50 to £5.50 per session.

The After School Club will increase

- from £7.25 to £8.75 per session for the 5pm pick up
and
- from £9.75 to £10.25 per session for the 5.30pm pick up

From Monday 7th December 2020 any sessions booked on the system will be subject to the higher rate detailed above. **It is strongly recommended that any sessions required in December are booked before the 7th December 2020 to ensure that the lower charge is applied.**

Parents will be unable to book January sessions until Monday 7th December when the new price rises will be in effect for all bookings to ensure that the price rise is fair to all families.

Discounts will continue to be applied for siblings attending the same sessions at After School Club

For your information, we have researched the prices of a number of local Breakfast and After School Clubs and our proposed increases continue to be competitive and offer good value for money.
